



GTL Ethical Purchasing Policy

GTL's policy is to purchase goods and services that:

- § Are produced and delivered under labour conditions that meet the local as well as national labour related regulations as well as SA 8000 social accountability standard and therefore do not involve the abuse or exploitation of any person
- § Have the least negative impact on climate change and the environment

Such considerations will form part of the evaluation and selection criteria for all goods and services purchased by GTL.

In addition, GTL will seek alternative sources where the conduct of suppliers demonstrably violates the basic rights of GTL's intended beneficiaries, and there is no willingness to address the situation within a reasonable time period, or where companies in the supply chain are involved in the manufacture or sale of arms in ways that are unacceptable to GTL.

The purpose of the policy is to:

- § Promote good Labour, Green House Gas Emission Reduction and Environmental Standards in the Suppliers and Supply Chain of GTL
- § Protect and Enhance GTL's reputation as an active campaigner on Labour and Climate Change issues
